

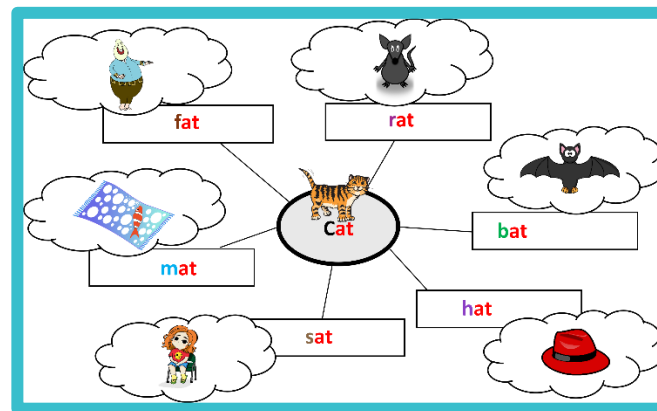
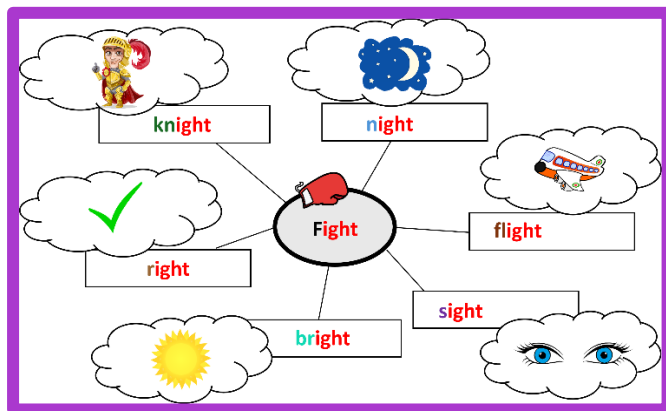
## Anchor Chart

- Introduce a word orally that has a common end rime / letter pattern e.g. **-at, -ight**
- Ask the learner if they know a word that might rhyme
- Use the alphabet arc / magnetic letters to build words, by changing the beginning sound.
- Make sure to point out that the end rime does not change.

### Anchor Chart Instructions:

- Use the printable anchor chart below
- Write the target word in the centre circle, highlight the end rime to draw attention to the letter pattern
- The pupil writes words with a different onset, into the surrounding boxes
- Draw pictures that will help the pupil remember each word
- Write a few sentences using words from the anchor chart

It is good practice that the end rime stays consistent in colour while you change the colour of the onset.
