


Use with phonically regular spelling

After introducing the new spelling pattern or concept and ensuring the pupil can read in-structure new word for spelling:

- 1. Helper says the target word (e.g. rink) while the learner looks closely at the helper's mouth
- 2. Learner repeats the word (e.g. rink)
- 3. Learner names the letters (e.g. r,i,n,k)
- 4. Learner writes the word naming the letters aloud as they write
- 5. Learner looks at and reads the word
- 6. Learner repeats the word across the page: 2-3 repetitions at least
- 7. Learner checks the word against the model (proofreading)
- 8. Repeat procedure for the next word



Remember:

Say the letter names as you write the word.
